Blessyn is just too young to be battling cancer.

She is only 9 years old and was recently diagnoses with Acute Myeloid Leukemia, a type of cancer of the blood and bone marrow.

Although just a few months ago she didn't have cancer, Blessyn's life is now centered around a treatment plan that consists of receiving chemotherapy treatment, IV fluids, antibiotics to prevent infection, and nausea medication; not to mention painful blood transfusions. In addition to being expensive, Blessyn's transfusions will take approximately 2 hours each and will often hurt – a lot.

The Children's Cancer & Blood Foundation (CCBF) is here to make sure Blessyn doesn't miss out on childhood, but we can't do it alone.
